Dear Participant in the 41st Annual Roslindale Day Parade:

The Roslindale Day Parade Committee welcomes your participation in our 41st Annual Parade on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>October 2nd</u>, <u>2016</u>. Enclosed in this package are your marching instructions, parade order, lineup formation, and maps of the assembly area and parade route.

- All vehicles and drivers participating in the parade must report to the assembly area no later than 11:30 a.m. on parade day so that the Police may conduct safety inspections. All others must be in place by 12:00 noon. The parade will step off at 1:00 p.m. sharp,
- Large vehicles such as trucks, flatbeds, floats will line up on Washington Street in proximity to the side street on which they are listed.
- 3. We are no longer sending out "Official Parade Vehicle" placards. Units with one or more vehicles in the parade are indicated by an asterisk (*) in the Parade Order. Our coordinators will verify and check off your vehicle(s) in the assembly area. Only vehicles authorized by the Parade Committee will be permitted to proceed in the parade.
- Vehicles not participating in the parade but dropping off parade participants should not enter the assembly area. See maps for unloading and parking locations.
- Please do not stop anywhere along the parade route and do not create a gap along the parade route. Performing units should keep moving forward as they pass the reviewing stand and filming location.
- Throwing candy and other things from vehicles is strictly forbidden by the Parade Committee and the Boston Police Department as a safety hazard. Have somebody walk alongside your vehicle handing these items out.
- 7. Please be aware that the Boston Police Department will be inspecting all vehicles in the parade to make sure that they comply with the enclosed Parade Vehicle Inspection Criteria. Please review the enclosed updated police regulations to ensure that your drivers and vehicles are properly licensed, registered, inspected, etc. and in full compliance with the safety rules.
- 8. Flatbed trucks on which participants are riding must have safety railings or secure barriers along the sides. Make sure all of your vehicle lights are working. NOTE THAT GENERATORS ARE PROHIBITED IN THE PARADE!!

Boston Police Department Parade Vehicle Inspection Criteria 2016

Drivers:

- 1) ALL drivers must have in possession a valid driver's license.
- 2) ALL drivers must have in possession registration for the vehicles they are operating.
- ALL CDL (Commercial Driver's License) drivers must be in compliance with the FMCSA.
 (Federal Motor Carrier Safety Act)
- 4) ALL CDL DRIVERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT MEDICAL CARD IN POSSESSION
- 5) The DRIVER is legally responsible for the actions of persons on vehicles and floats

Vehicles:

- 1) ALL CDL vehicles must be in compliance with FMCSA.
- 2) **ALL** vehicles, trailers, floats, and musical platforms must be properly registered and licensed by the Registry of Motor Vehicles.
- 3) ALL vehicles must have a valid state inspection.
- 4) ALL vehicles including floats must have working brake lights & turn signals
- 5) **ALL** vehicles including floats must have properly functioning brakes, including air brakes and tow-away and breakaway.
- 6) ALL floats & trailers must use safety chains and be properly secured with a legal hitch
- 7) <u>ALL</u> props on floats & trailers must be properly secured, braced or tied down to prevent movement.
- 8) ALL floats & trailers must provide adequate safety measures for all riders to prevent falling from platforms. Hand holds for each rider. NO GOING OFF AND ON TRUCK BEDS or FLOATS

Parade Vehicle Inspection Criteria 2016 (continued)

- 9) **NO** oversize floats or vehicles. Maximum width of 102" (8 1/2 feet). Maximum length of trailer depends on parade route and is not to exceed 53'. Only **single** trailer/float units.
- 10) NO throwing of any articles from the vehicles, floats, or trailers
- 11) **NO** vehicles with defective tires
- NO vehicles with suspension defects.
- 13) **NO** vehicles with visible fuel leaks.
- NO overweight vehicles.
- 15) **NO** overloaded vehicles
- 16) NO alcohol on vehicles or floats
- 17) NO overheight vehicles. Maximum 13' 6" (includes people standing on vehicle)
- NO staging to be built on trailer bed unless load conforms to Local, State & Federal Safety Regulations.
- 19) NO MUSIC OR NOISE EMANATION WITHIN STAGING AREA

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

NO GASOLINE POWERED GENERATORS!

DIESEL GENERATORS MUST HAVE PERMIT FROM FIRE PREVENTION

NO CYLINDERS or CONTAINERS OF ANY TYPE of GASES OR FUELS

DIRECTIONS TO THE 41st ANNUAL ROSLINDALE DAY PARADE

Sunday, October 2nd, 2016

Please plan your arrival by 11:30 a.m. in the Assembly Area.
Parade steps off at 1:00 p.m. SHARP. Thank you.

FROM ROUTE 128

- Take Exit15A, the Dedham to 1A exit, which will bring you onto Providence Highway (Route 1 North). Proceed straight ahead. You will pass will pass Legacy Place on the right. Then you will pass Dedham Plaza on the left and Best Buy and BJ's on the right.
- GET IN THE RIGHT LANE as you approach the next set of lights. You should be in the
 furthest right lane before you get to STAPLES (on the right). You will see a bridge
 ahead of you just beyond the lights.
- Proceed over the bridge. STAY IN THE FURTHEST RIGHT LANE AND HUG THE BLACK CHAIN LINK FENCE. As you go over the bridge, you will see a green sign saying "Washington Street, Roslindale, Forest Hills, Next Right"
- BEAR RIGHT ONTO WASHINGTON STREET* as you go over the bridge. You will see Fedex/Office and Bob's Furniture across the street from where you are bearing right. There is also a green sign pointing right to "Washington Street, Roslindale, Forest Hills".
- Continue northbound on Washington St. for approximately three and half miles to Roslindale Village. As you enter Roslindale Village, you will note prominent landmarks such as Brayton's Custom Upholstery and the Bank of America sign on the left, followed by Adams Park. You have reached the Assembly Area. See map for unloading and parking areas.

*IF YOU MISS THE TURN ONTO WASHINGTON STREET

Note: If you miss this critical turn onto Washington Street going over the bridge you can get back onto Washington Street by going through the Dedham Mall at the next set of lights. Bear right before the lights at the Pizzeria Uno and proceed straight ahead through the Mall, up the hill. Take a left onto Washington Street at the A.C. Moore Arts and Crafts Store.

FROM POINTS SOUTH

- From Route 3 and Route 24, follow the signs to Route 128 north (I-95) to Dedham.
- Get off 128 at Exit 15A, the Dedham to 1A exit, and follow the directions above.

FROM POINTS WEST

- Take the Mass. Pike (I-90) or Route 9 to Route 128 South (I-95).
- Get off 128 at Exit 15A, the Dedham to 1A exit, and follow the directions above.

Directions to Roslindale Day Parade - Sunday, October 2nd, 2016 (continued)

FROM INTERSTATE 93

 Take the exit for Route 203 WEST (Exit 11B from North, and Exit 11 from South). Follow Granite Ave. for ¼ of a mile and take a left on Gallivan Boulevard at the Eire Pub, which is Route 203 West. Proceed on Route 203 West, which will follow Gallivan Boulevard in Dorchester and merge into Morton St. at Norfolk Hardware.

(NOTE: THE CASEY OVERPASS HAS JUST BEEN TORN DOWN AND THE AREA AROUND FOREST HILLS IS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION)

• After about four miles on Route 203 you will encounter the a construction area with jersey barriers leading to rotary just before the former Casey Overpass, which has just been torn down. Navigate through the jersey barriers by following the flashing arrows. Bear right where you see the set of three flashing arrows and stay in the left lane until you reach the first set of lights. Take a left. You will pass Forest Hills Station on the right. Get in the right lane. Take a right at the third set of lights onto Ukraine Way. Take a left at the lights onto Washington Street and proceed straight ahead about one mile to the parade assembly area.

(Note if you miss the left turn before Forest Hills you can take a left at the next set of lights. This will also lead to Washington Street on the other side of Forest Hills Station)

FROM THE JAMAICAWAY

Note: Trucks and Buses are prohibited on the Jamaicaway

• At the rotary of the Jamaicaway and Route 203 (near Arnold Arboretum), continue through the rotary following the Route 203 signs. Stay in the right lane. You will pass the deconstructed Casey Overpass on the right. Hug the jersey barriers on the right and take a right at the first set of lights, which will lead to Washington Street. You will pass Forest Hills Station on the left. Proceed about one mile up Washington Street to the assembly area of the Parade.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION


- Take the ORANGE LINE or a BUS to Forest Hills Station.
- From Forest Hills Station, the following bus routes stop in Roslindale Village and have service on Sunday:
 - #30 Mattapan Station Forest Hills Station
 - #34/34E Walpole Center or Dedham Line Forest Hills Station
 - #35 Dedham Mall / Stimson St. Forest Hills Station
 - #36 Charles River Loop or V.A. Hospital Forest Hills Station
 - #40 Georgetown Forest Hills Station
 - #50 Cleary Square Forest Hills Station

(Note: Buses will be re-routed once the assembly area streets are blocked off.

However, if necessary the Parade assembly area is within walking distance from Forest

Hills station, only about one mile up Washington Street)
